"I was able to get time with our Senators to talk about local issues that are important to our community in LaGrange," said Councilmember Gaskin. "I talked to Senator Reverend Warnock and Senator Ossoff personally about identifying grants and appropriations for important issues like infrastructure, youth violence, transportation, and senior housing."

More than a thousand local leaders visited Capitol Hill March 11-13 to meet with members of Congress and advocate for their communities.
