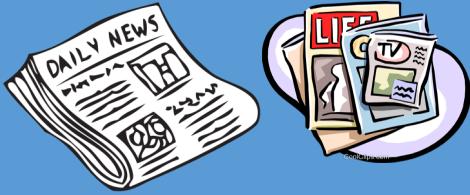
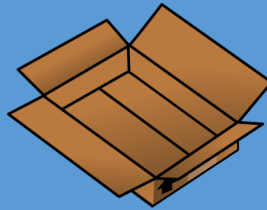


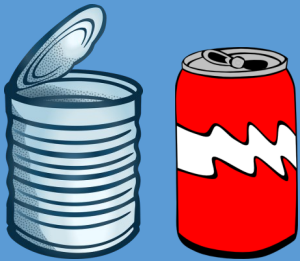
What Can You Recycle?



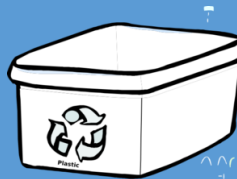
Newspapers, magazines, office paper, and junk mail (including clear window envelopes)



Cardboard, chipboard, & cereal boxes, broken down (no pizza boxes)



Tin cans, aluminum cans rinsed & clean



Plastic containers, bottles, and jugs rinsed & clean

Marked with these recycling designations:

No need to separate items, they all go in the bin together.

Recycling bins and their collection are free!



PLEASE DO NOT BAG ANY ITEMS

These items do not go in the bin:

Glass of any kind

Coated cardboard (milk cartons, juice boxes, etc)

Styrofoam of any kind

Plastic shopping bags
