***UPDATE* Weather Delays Downtown Construction to Bull & Main Streets**

LaGrange, Ga. November 30, 2017 – The City of LaGrange wants to advise residents construction on Bull and Main Streets is now delayed because of recent weather conditions.

The final striping and opening of Bull Street has been postponed until the beginning of next week. The pavement has been too wet to apply the thermoplastic.

There will be a new traffic pattern on Bull Street and Main Street in downtown LaGrange.

Bull Street will have a new one-way pattern that will intersect with Byron Hurst Street.



Traffic along Byron Hurst and East Depot will be required to stop but Bull Street traffic will now flow thru without stopping and will flow around the back of Wild Leap Brewery and the city's proposed skate park.

Bull Street will intersect Main Street at an island where traffic north on Main will now be one way. Traffic south of this intersection on Main will remain two way traffic.
