LaGrange, Ga. September 27, 2019 – Friends of The Thread and the Callaway Foundation held a ribbon cutting ceremony for Phase 4 of The Thread.

The event was held at the new boardwalk along Country Club Road Thursday, September 26th.

The Callaway Foundation held a dedication in memory of long-time employee Bruce Pearson. His wife Catherine unveiled the new sign dedicating the boardwalk to Bruce.

This 1.6 mile scenic segment is now open to the public.

The fifth segment will connect the trail head at Twin Cedars through Calumet Park ending at Union Street. This segment is expected to be completed in the next few months.

More on The Thread: The Thread is an environmentally sensitive, non-motorized, multipurpose trail designed to increase the health and wellness of the community through providing a safe environment in LaGrange, Georgia for fitness, recreation, transportation and special events. Currently, The Thread has a total 29 miles of trails planned.
