Wild Leap Brewery to Open in Downtown LaGrange Saturday

LaGrange, Ga. September 21, 2017 – Wild Leap Brewery is celebrating its grand opening Saturday afternoon.

The much-anticipated craft brewery grand opening is scheduled for 3-8pm, but will be open to the public from 8pm until midnight.

Co-owners Rob Goldstein and Anthony Rodriguez build the brewery after bringing the city's

first beer festival to town two years ago.

“The beer festival was such a huge success, it inspired us,” said Rodriguez.

“We found there is a huge market in this town and we are very excited to be a part of the growth in downtown LaGrange.”

Rodriguez says he and Goldstein were immediately impressed by the abandoned Westbrook Tire building on Main Street and its Art Deco design.

Today, with the support of the City of LaGrange and the Callaway Foundation, the building has transformed into a trendy craft brewery injecting energy into the south side of downtown.

Wild Leap will feature a tasting room, a large event space, and an outdoor patio that will have a view of the downtown plaza.

Wild Leap Beer is already served in many of the restaurants and bars in downtown LaGrange. The craft beer is also served in establishments in Atlanta and Columbus.

“I’m very excited these young men and their local investors decided to make this investment in LaGrange,” said LaGrange Mayor Jim Thornton.

“I know their business will be a success and another great draw for downtown LaGrange.”
